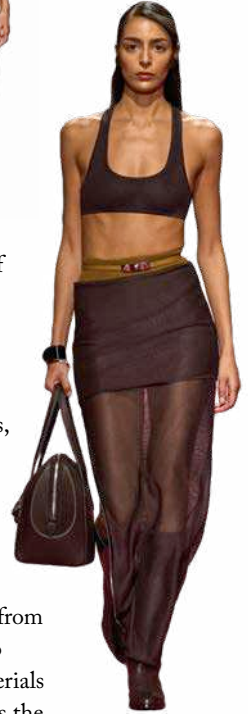

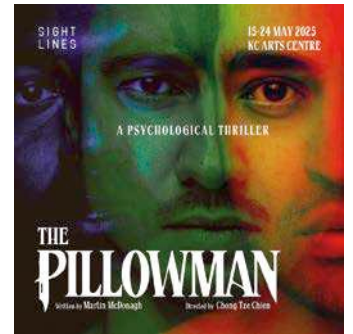

By working with wind, water and weather, they also develop an understanding of **sustainability** and the importance of **preserving** the planet.

DISNEYLAND PARIS

Disneyland's timeless charm speaks to all generations, making it a wonderful theme park for family holidays. The Paris park has a certain *je ne sais quoi*, making it a worthy pit stop during any European holiday. For example, it's the only park in the world to have an animatronic dragon sleeping in a grotto under its Sleeping Beauty Castle. Come close enough, and the dragon roars, breathing smoke in a theatrical display of prowess that will excite the imaginations of visitors young and old. Younger children can meet their favourite Disney characters



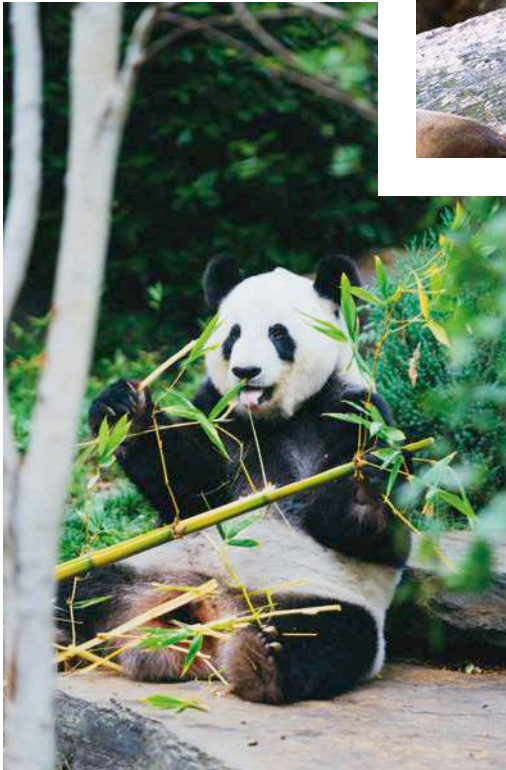

and enjoy gentle rides such as *It's a Small World* and *Dumbo the Flying Elephant*, while older kids and teens can seek thrills on attractions including *Avengers Flight Force* and *Big Thunder Mountain*. Parents and grandparents can soak in the park's enchanting atmosphere, and indulge in fine dining at *Bistrot Chez Rémy*, themed after *Ratatouille*. On Mother's Day and Father's Day, the park also runs special activities, such as free carnations for mums, and special teatime menus with treats that speak to the occasion. Finally, the park is conveniently located at the entrance of a train station, making it convenient for families with strollers.

Once you're done with your Paris trip, take the Eurostar over to London and extend the family vacation. While there, recharge at the iconic *St. James' Hotel and Club* (stjameshotelandclub.com).



OCEAN PARK, HONG KONG

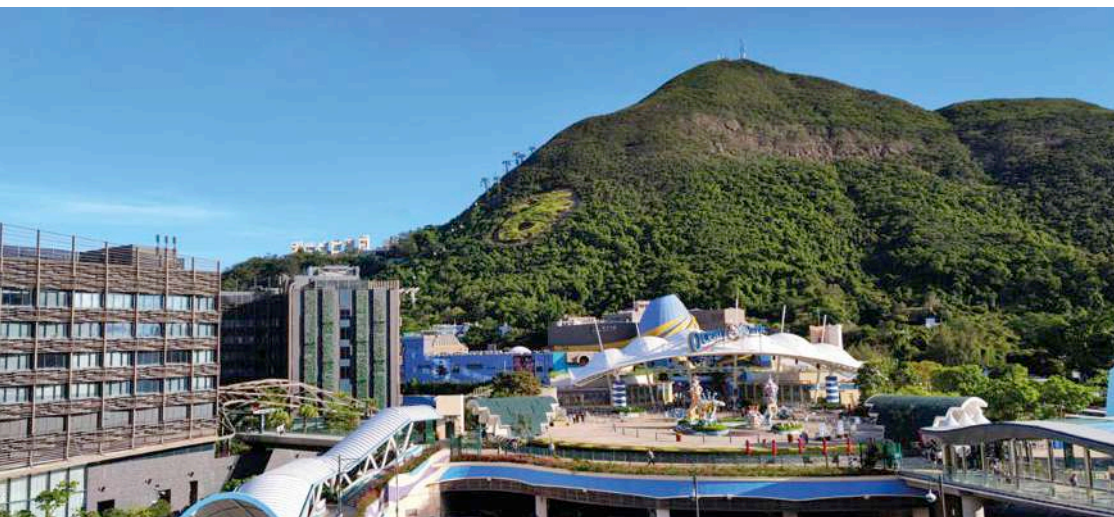
Wildlife and theme park thrills go hand-in-hand at Ocean Park, located on Hong Kong Island. This sprawling park combines an aquarium, zoo and amusement rides, making it one of the largest theme parks in Asia. To start the day, traverse the park in the cable car with views of the surrounding sea as the backdrop. Stop at Whiskers Harbour, a 14,200sqm section of the park dedicated to attractions for the little ones— think jungle gyms to merry-go-rounds. Graduate to the various zoo and aquarium zones, where encounters with over 6,500 different animals await, from Arctic foxes to giant pandas. Animal feeding sessions and demonstrations are also the perfect opportunity for nature-loving families to get up close and personal with animals and learn facts about the importance of conservation. The adrenaline junkies in the clan can take on several of the park's intense rollercoasters, including the floorless Hair Raiser that features a loop 35m off the ground.

WINDING TIME

ARMED WITH A DOCTORATE IN
PHILANTHROPY, JIN WU IS ON A MISSION
TO REDEFINE LUXURY WITH INNOVATION
AND BENEVOLENCE.

It's a beautiful day and an interview with entrepreneur, author and philanthropist Jin Wu in the private dining hall of Latitude Restaurant & Terrace is the perfect complement. The conversation goes from preloved luxury watches and bags to philanthropy and a quirky distinctive morning routine—all within one family and within Far East Plaza. Well, almost all... the quirk is entirely Jin's.

Jin grew up around luxury watches but she is as much an entrepreneur as she is a watch lover. She founded Richman Luxury that specialises in watch winders for automatic watches—and complements her father's business Goldman Luxury—her family owns three stores, including hers, in the mall.

FILLING THE VOID

The idea for Richman Luxury was sparked both by her passion for automatic watches and the realisation that there was a lack of affordable, high-quality watch winders in the market. Jin's business is one among just two in Singapore specialising in this sector.

"It's a very niche market, in fact, very, very niche," explains Jin, adding that Richman's customer base extends through the Asia-Pacific region.

There was definitely a void that needed filling, as Jin noticed among Goldman customers that a lot of watch enthusiasts and collectors were at a loss when it came to maintaining their watch. "They often find their watches showing the wrong time or date and they have to wind it each time before wearing it", which is more of a problem than a solution, says Jin. "The correct way of taking care of the watches, especially luxury timepieces, is to put them in the watch winder because there's an optimal rotation where you can wind, and then after that, they will give you the current day and time."

Richman Luxury's watch winders are custom built into boxes with storage as per the needs of the customer and the number of watches owned. Richman's watch winders prioritise eco-friendly materials and environmentally friendly manufacturing processes. Beyond that, Jin is also able to advise customers on the right settings—in watch-winder speak, the number of turns and their direction—depending on the watch or watches they own. "Majority of the models, including Rolex, are

dual direction with 650 to 850 turns per day being optimal. On the other hand, Patek Philippe watches need 1,000 and above turns per day," says Jin with a smile. "Each day, there is a new watch launch; I am still learning."

A BETTER WORLD

The thirst for knowledge and to keep upskilling herself kept Jin going through the pandemic when her family business, as did other businesses, found itself unable to accept customers. The business adapted and forged their digital presence while Jin set along a different path.

"The challenges and uncertainties of COVID-19 made me reflect on my priorities and the impact I could make on the world," says Jin. During that time, she co-wrote the book *Love Can Bring Peace and Happiness During Setback!* and acquired a doctorate in Philanthropy from St. Mother Theresa University, India.


"Mother Teresa is my biggest inspiration. I deeply admire her relentless pursuit of love and kindness, her humility, deep faith and dedication to serving the poorest of the poor," says Jin.

Jin has since also founded the Richman Foundation. "When I launched Richman Luxury, we were discussing the names and this was the most meaningful—not about a man rich in wealth, but rich in love and humility," explains Jin. The foresight that went into the name now fits right in with the foundation's core values of "humanity, peace, love, justice, and trust". Aligning with the 2030 agenda of United

Nations' Sustainable Development Goals, Richman Foundation focuses on initiatives such as providing free meals for orphans and under-privileged children as well as their emotional development. "The goal is to create a healthier and a more compassionate world," says Jin.

The list of innovative initiatives includes the Santa Claus Mission to Millions where kids around the world receive unexpected gifts in the form of free meals, quality education, as well as educational scholarships. Richman Foundation has a presence in Singapore, Malaysia, India, and some African countries.

Jin is currently in the midst of filming a documentary "to spread the message out to the world that this group of children need our attention" she says. She hopes that it will one day be aired on international streaming channels.

Entrepreneurship runs deep in Jin's veins as does the drive to leave the world a better place than she found it. Her desire for a more responsive world aligns with her verve for a future where sustainability and luxury horology can co-exist.

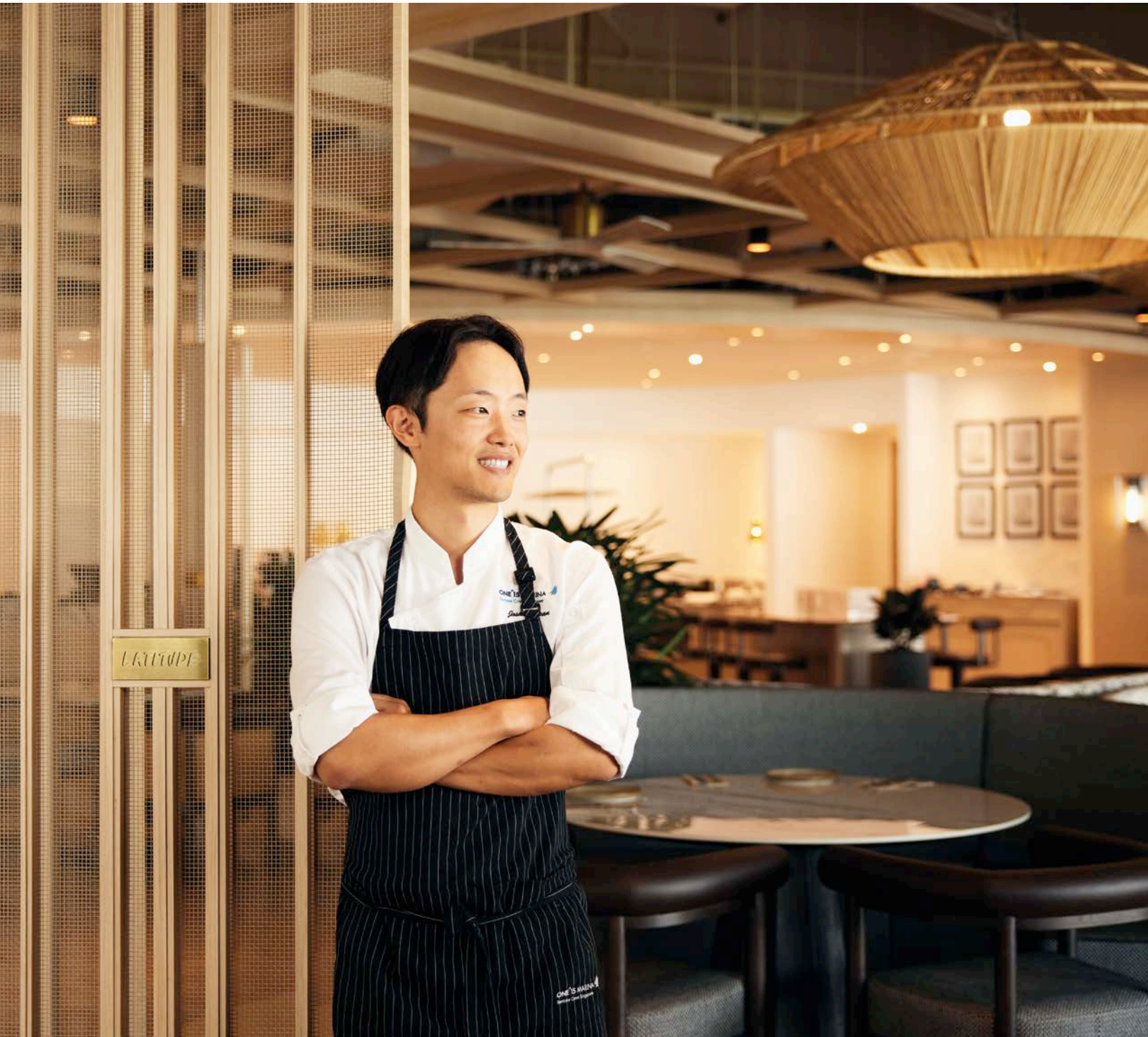
WATER

HEART TO TABLE

Walking through the doors of Latitude Restaurant & Terrace is like entering a whole new era for the Club—where polished resort meets contemporary fine-dining meets chic nautical. Yet there’s this palpably pleasant air of nostalgia about it; the sense of place that Members love and return for.

Chef Jun, the restaurant’s new Head Chef, mirrors that sensibility in his mission to refresh the menu offerings while retaining classic flavours and traditional influences. Scallop ceviche, foie gras, abalone soup, and bouillabaisse made with a Korean twist were the dishes he first prepared and proposed for the refreshed set menu. “It must have been a success; that’s why I am here,” he shrugs with a laugh.

LIVING A DREAM

Hailing from Young In, just outside Seoul, Korea, Chef Jun knew he wanted to be a chef quite early in his life, but not just any chef. “I wanted to be a unique chef. That’s why I came to Singapore—to learn English and a new culture,” he says.

He moved to Singapore about seven years ago, working his way up in small kitchens on the island. His big break came with the now-defunct Black Swan, which was part of the hospitality group Lo & Behold. A year at Black Swan and a Japanese restaurant under the same umbrella equipped him with the skills he needed for the industry, but it was with three-Michelin-starred Odette that his repertoire in French cuisine took flight—and got his foot in the door to the fine-dining arena.

The experience gave him more than a casual introduction to French cuisine, but it was hard work, Chef Jun admits. “It was really, really tough, but the longer I stayed, the more I learnt and wanted to do more. It was an experience like no other,” he explains.

He, however, had to cut short his tenure, as he moved back to Korea to finish his Diploma in culinary studies. He joined the Club shortly after his return to Singapore.

INSPIRED PROCESS

“It is more French-Korean. The base is French but infused with Korean flavours,” says Chef Jun of his style of cooking and what he proposes to do with the restaurant’s menu.

Although his leanings towards the latter is understandable considering his heritage, he credits his mother and grandmother for inspiring him to experiment with it. “My grandmother, especially. She lives on a farm on an island off Seoul. Everything about her cooking—from her kimchi to the dough she prepares—evokes freshness. She would make everything by hand. Simple, uncomplicated farm-fresh goodness.”

Making dumplings with her for Lunar New Year is one of his fondest childhood memories. “I used to watch my grandmother while she cooked; her process of cooking from scratch. She inspired me to become a chef as I have always loved using my hands to create things.”

He is thrilled to be able to exercise his creativity in a vibrant, diverse atmosphere such as the Club.

THE RIGHT PLACE

Working in a multi-cultural kitchen comprising Koreans, Malaysians and Singaporeans is something that he finds equally refreshing. “The team here is very good, I really enjoy working with them,” he says. “But I want things to be perfect—at a 100%. As most of them have been in the restaurant for over eight years, some methods can take a bit of time to unlearn, but they are all very flexible and eager to learn,” he adds.

Being surrounded by passionate and hardworking colleagues and mentors throughout his career is something Chef Jun deeply appreciates. He has learnt many valuable lessons across various kitchens, thanks to the patience—and sometimes, tough love—of his chef mentors. “They just remind me to always do better.”

Chef Jun started at Latitude Restaurant & Terrace about three months ago, just before it went through its major renovation. It is his first experience working in a Club environment, but it has certainly ticked off more than one item on his wishlist: to work in a restaurant environment (as against one that is hotel-attached) and have some work-life balance.

That said, the “process” is always on his mind. He takes screenshots of the things that spark his imagination—colours, shapes and patterns—and tries to incorporate it in his dishes and presentation. “It’s something I think about all the time,” he shares, even on weekends at a cafe or bistro out with his girlfriend. “It’s like a stressbuster for me!” At the time of this interview in early February, that mindspace has been taken over by the Valentine’s Day menu. “It is the first thing I think about when I wake up and my last thought for the day.” 📷

CHEF JUN’S TOP 3

CRAVING

My comfort food is Korean cold noodles, *naengmyeon*. I also like local prawn mee. That’s the advantage of Singapore, you can try various cuisines. There are more Michelin-starred restaurants here than in Korea.

GOAL

I would like to learn how to make Japanese food. The cuisine is pretty close to Korean cuisine. I have never been to Japan either—it’s on my wishlist.

TRAVEL

I enjoy snorkelling and my best experience so far has been in Cebu, Philippines, with my childhood friend. That was a long time ago, when we were both single.



CHARTING FREEDOM

BAREBOAT SAILING IS LIKE THE ULTIMATE SOURCE OF FREEDOM ON OPEN WATER. HERE'S HOW TO PLAN AN UNFORGETTABLE ADVENTURE.

If you enjoy sailing, a terrific way to see the non-touristy areas of some amazing countries is to charter a sailboat. There are many areas of the world with somewhat remote islands that receive very little tourist traffic. It can be a fun adventure, physically and technically demanding yet relaxing. Or, leave all that stuff to someone else and lap up the experience.

THE RIGHT BOAT

It's very easy to find charter companies online. The largest global company is Sunsail. I have used them many times but have also used local companies if they have a better selection. Reviews make it easy to pick a good one. The first decision to make: monohull or catamaran. Both have their advantages. Then come the size and age—I've always leaned towards larger sized boats. For one, they have much more space and they also sail faster. Size and age can also determine the equipment on board, from a well-equipped galley (kitchen), large navigation station, more than one head (martoilet), and good-sized cabins (bedrooms) and saloon (living room). Larger-sized boats might also have hydraulic winches—a bit of a luxury but awesome help if the other crew don't have a lot of experience. This was a godsend for me in Croatia one year when the only other real sailor on the boat broke a foot and I had to single-hand the boat from the second day onwards after a brief hospital visit. Safety onboard is also a key consideration—for example, if you have small children, you can request netting from the charter company all around the boat so no one tumbles off.

The charter company can also help with initial food and provisions. While you can easily go to a supermarket before departing and buy what you need, many companies have an online provisioning system. These will be on board for you when you take delivery of the boat. It is recommended to choose non-perishables only, and then go to a store to pick up fresh fruit, vegetables, meat, and more. Overall, the costs work out to be very reasonable as compared to two hotel rooms per night for a family of four.

YOUR SAILING GROUNDS

When it comes to location, it is important to consider your own skill level and experiences related to tides, wind speeds, density of other boat traffic, as well as how relaxing you want the whole experience to be.

Most popular sailing places around the world have published books (called pilots) that give extremely detailed information on routes, prevailing winds and currents, anchorages, mooring buoys, marinas for fuel and water, and provisioning. I have always studied

these well in advance and chosen my route based on many factors. This also engages your fellow passengers in having a say on where to go.

If it's your first time, pick somewhere easy like the Aeolian Islands, Italy, which is a short motor or motor-sail ride from Palermo. Once you reach the islands, everything is line-of-sight, winds blowing mostly in a low and constant direction. The Pontine Islands near Naples are also easy. The Dalmatians in Croatia have stronger winds, but fantastic and well-priced marinas. There are also many other places to sail to like the Greek or Turkish islands. Over towards the Americas, there are so many choices with the easiest and most well-designed for sailing being the British Virgin Islands (BVI), all the way to the spectacular St Barth's and Saint Kitts. The last few are slightly more complicated as different islands can be owned by different countries and require inbound and outbound immigration and quarantine (CIQ). Much closer to home, we have Phuket. Charter from the Northeast and do a clockwise loop covering famous locations such as Krabi and Phi Phi.

Picking a location also depends on what you want to see, the time of year—taking local weather conditions into consideration—and also the difficulty

with friends, but, for chartering, I've always done it with family. You would want to make sure that everyone on board has spent a fair bit of time on the water though; it would be a real holiday-spoiler if someone discovered they didn't like the sea or was a danger onboard. Seasickness can be well managed by over-the-counter drugs,

supplements, wristbands and more, but it would take a bit of time to get used to a boat's head (marine toilet).

I have global offshore sailing qualifications but that isn't necessary in a lot of places when you are chartering your bareboat. What they will look for is experience, something like a sailing resume. Some countries, however, are strict on qualifications and also have unique requirements. For example, in Croatia, you will need a radio operator's certification.

TAKE IN THE SIGHTS

Although the actual sailing is fun, the best part is all the amazing places you can drop the pick—drop anchor at for lunch or for the night. Almost all charter operators will insist that you stay stationary by early evening. You can either anchor, attach to a mooring buoy, or dock in a marina. Anchoring is free and buoys can be free or chargeable depending on who maintains them while marinas come with a cost. But with marinas, there's the convenience of being able to walk ashore, as against using your dinghy or tender, and they have shore power, water facilities and showers.

The places you can go ashore at, though, are spectacular and receive very little visitors. In Europe in particular, you may be able to stop at 1,000-year-old villages with churches, shops and restaurants. You can eat and drink for a reasonably low price and get a real local experience.

If you choose to stay in a marina, here are some points to consider. Firstly, depending on the location, they can be cheap or cost a lot. For example, you can stay in a beautiful, modern marina in Croatia for well under 100 euros, but expect to pay well over 250 euros at Capri in Italy.

Many marinas in Europe use the Mediterranean Mooring system, which can take some getting used to. You either drop anchor some ways out or pick up a line from a buoy and reverse in, stern-to, a wall. This can be extremely daunting when you have multi-million-dollar superyachts on either side of you and a hundred people watching you in the hope of catching some action.

My preference has always been to anchor or grab a mooring. I also love the whole experience of taking the dinghy to shore—although, depending on the waves, there might be some complaints about damp butts. It's all part of the experience, though. If you do take a dinghy, remember to take into account the tides—whether you should tie it to a dock or leave it on the beach. Otherwise, you might have a little surprise when you return after dinner! Make sure you have at least one flashlight for the journey back to your boat. Do also remember to leave an anchor light on if not in a designated anchor area.

Most importantly, enjoy the experience—it's addictive. 📌



rating. Although you could simply circumnavigate one island—like Majorca, for example—I've always preferred island-hopping. Some areas, like the BVIs or Aeolian Islands will be line-of-sight sailing, and others, like the Caribbean and Greece require some good navigation skills. Although GPS and chart plotters have made this easy, it's always good to have a paper chart—I would consider it essential, in case electronics fail.

Another important consideration is whether you want to "bareboat" or hire a skipper. I have sailed for a long time, and I prefer the privacy and freedom of skippering myself. I have raced yachts over the years





TASTE OF LOVE

GIVING THANKS AND CELEBRATING MOTHER'S AND FATHER'S DAY THROUGH FOOD.

SIMNEL CAKE

A fruitcake popular in the United Kingdom, Simnel cake was originally consumed by those fasting for Lent. Daughters baked it for their mums on the fourth day of Lent as a treat for Mothering Sunday. Back in the 16th century, when the custom originated, it was a day when people would return to their “mother church” to give thanks to their mothers. The day has evolved into Mother’s day—and now celebrated in May, but Simnel Cake remains a feature. Loaded with dried fruit, the cake is distinguished by layers of marzipan—almond paste in some—on top and in the middle. It’s topped with eleven marzipan balls, representing the eleven apostles of Christ—minus Judas—and sometimes has one in the middle.

FUN FACT

It is believed that Mother’s Day is rooted in ancient Roman culture—as a homage to Juno and Cybele, the Roman goddesses of motherhood and marriage. But the fact that it was celebrated earlier in March reveals closer ties to Mothering Sunday.



MOUSSE DE MARACUJÁ

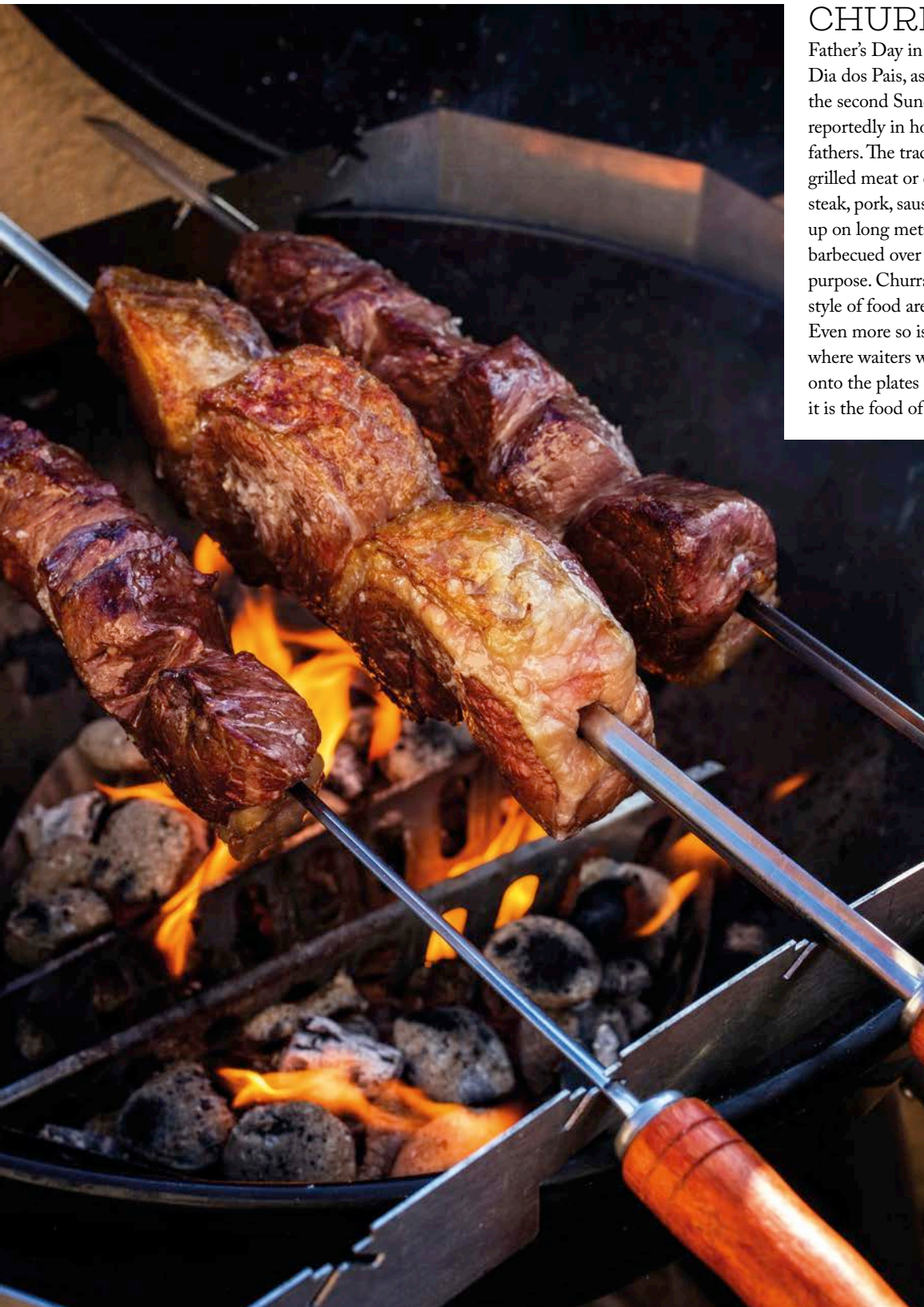
In a country such as Brazil where celebrations are family-centric, Mother's Day or Dia das Mães holds a special place. Taking on more of a multigenerational approach, mothers, aunts and grandmothers are invited to join in the festivities. Flowers are a given—native varieties including Camelia rose, begonia, freesia, hibiscus, and the Cattleya orchid, Brazil's national flower. Celebrations around the table and delectable desserts are other highlights, especially Mousse de maracujá. Maracujá, Portuguese for passion fruit, is native to the region of southern Brazil and the hero

ingredient of this dessert, while condensed milk, cream, and sometimes, gelatin lend to its signature less-aerated texture. The result, a dessert that is sweet, tangy and creamy all at once.

FUN FACT

This popular passion fruit mousse was created in Brazil during the '60s as part of a campaign by Nestlé to boost sales of their condensed milk product, Leite Moça. The food conglomerate worked with cooking schools to incorporate the ingredient into Brazil's cuisine, changing the face of the country's desserts.





CHURRASCO

Father's Day in Brazil, however, is all about meat. Dia dos Pais, as the day is called, is celebrated on the second Sunday of August in the country—reportedly in honour of Saint Joachim, patron of fathers. The tradition is to indulge in signature grilled meat or churrasco. Large pieces of meat—steak, pork, sausage, and chicken—are loaded up on long metal skewers or wooden stakes and barbecued over a grill specially made for this purpose. Churrasqueira, as restaurants serving this style of food are known, are synonymous in Brazil. Even more so is the eat-all-you-can serving style, where waiters walk around, slicing off the meat onto the plates of the diners. It is no surprise that it is the food of choice on Father's Day.

FUN FACT

The origins of Churrasco are said to go as far back as the late 1600s to the indigenous people of the Rio Grande or Rio Grande do Sul, who used to skewer the day's hunt in pieces on a wooden stake and grill it on a pit. The semi-nomadic people moved on to become cattle breeders and ranchers, but the grilling style remained.



TORTA DELLA MAMMA

The name literally translates to “mother’s cake”—enough said. The close relationship between grandmothers, mothers and food in Italy is legendary, but they get the day off on this special day. It is customary for families to indulge mothers with Torta della Mamma—made of shortcrust pastry, it is filled with pastry cream, and topped with pine nuts and loving messages of appreciation. While regional versions may differ, quintessentially Italian flavours of almond, lemon or chocolate rule the roost.

FUN FACT

The tradition of celebrating Mother’s Day in Italy is said to have originated in 1957 in Assisi and by a Parish priest—almost 50 years since it became commercialised in the United States. The flower often gifted on Mother’s Day is the mimosa, symbolising the strength and sensitivity of motherhood.

MEAT HASH

Mother's Day in Ethiopia coincides with the end of the rainy season and is celebrated in either October or November rather than May. Extending for three days, Antrosht as it is called, is a celebration of mothers and Mother Nature and commemorated with a feast involving a traditional hash dish. Daughters traditionally bring the vegetables, butter, spices, and cheese, while sons bring the meat varieties such as lamb or bull. Mothers then combine all the ingredients and cook a delicious hash. Other traditional dishes such as injera—a

flatbread made from teff flour—also adorn the communal table, along with some stews or wats, and Ethiopian fruit punch. Joyful singing and dancing follow the feasting. 🍴

FUN FACT

There are many origin stories for hash as a dish—the English are known to have been making hash as early as the 14th century using leftovers from a dinner of meat and vegetables. The dish reportedly derives its name from the French word "hacher" meaning "to chop".

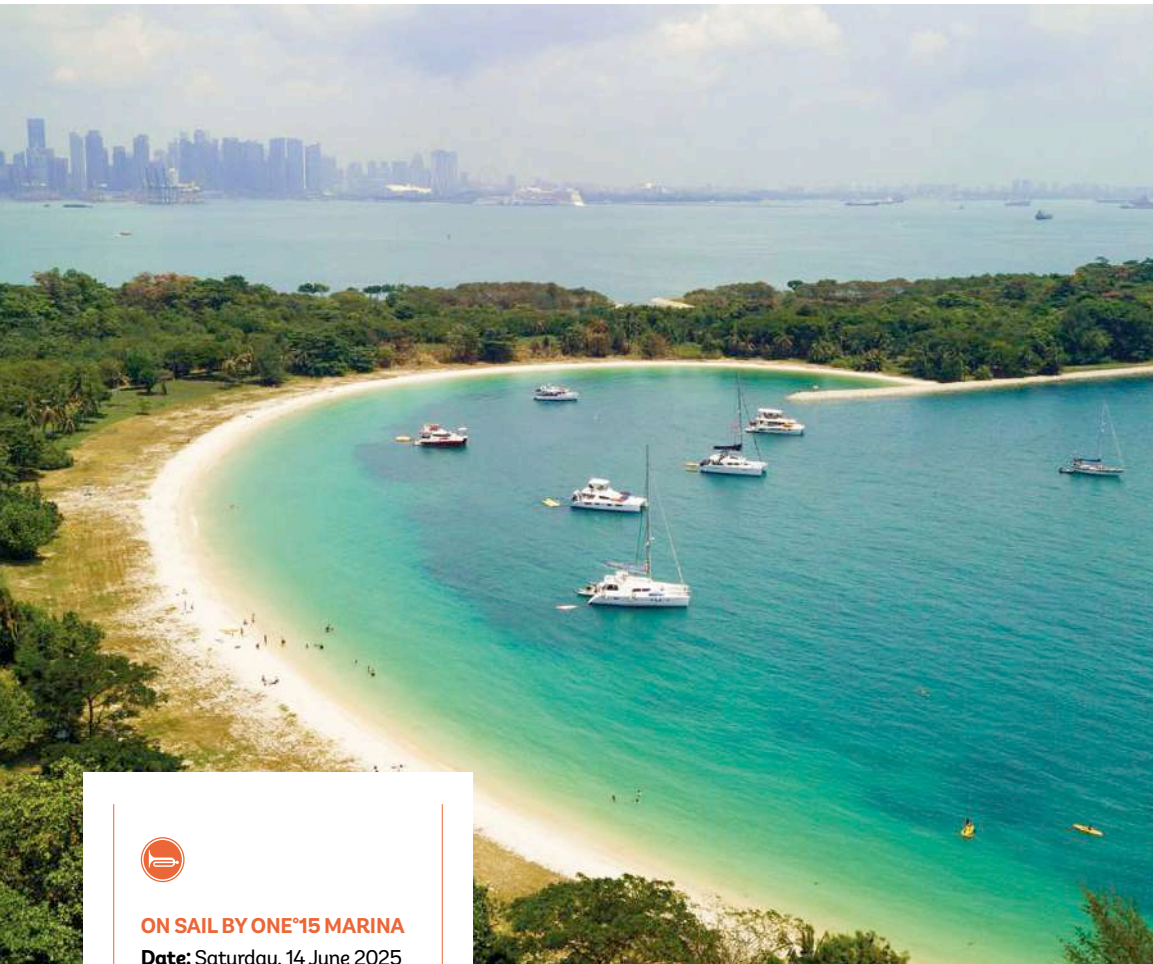

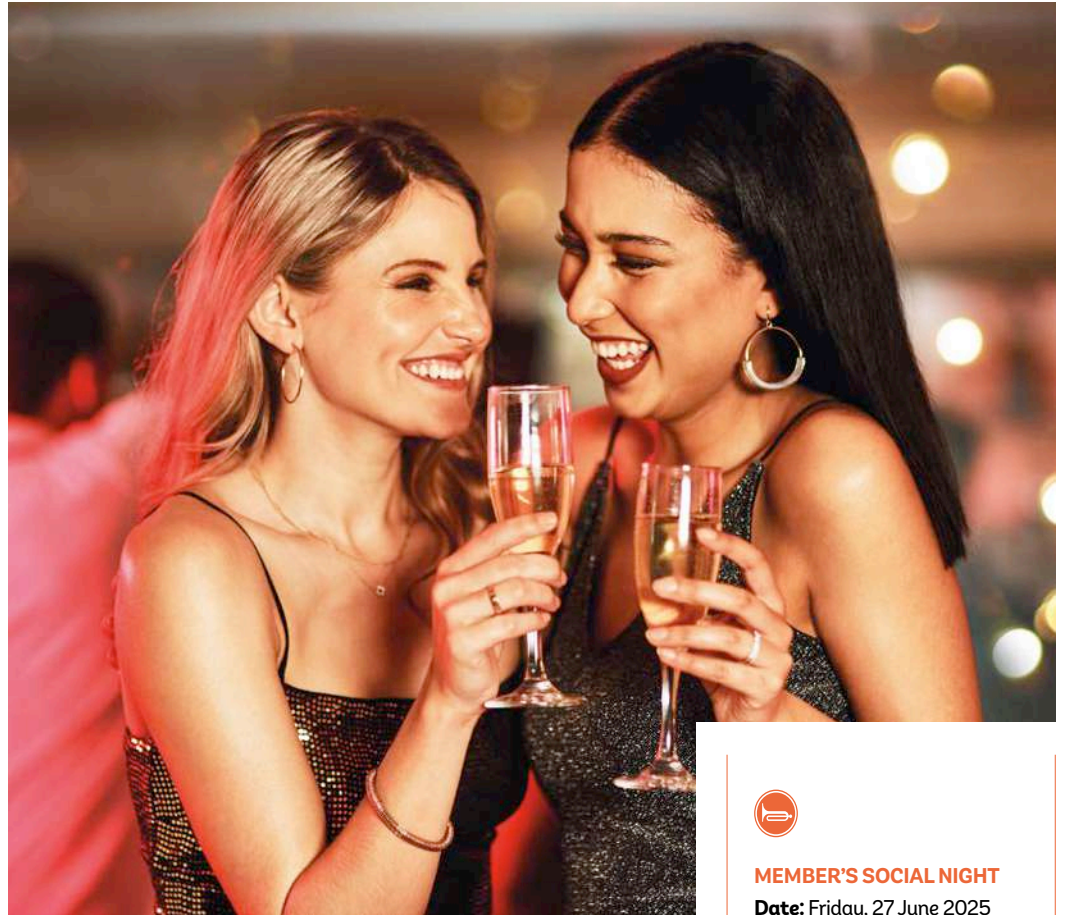
